**Lake Tahoe, January 22, 2007** - The Tahoe Regional Planning Agency (TRPA) will recognize the winners of the 2006 Best in the Basin Awards at its Governing Board meeting on Wednesday, January 24 at the North Lake Tahoe Conference Center in Kings Beach, CA.

For the past 17 years, TRPA's Best in the Basin awards program has recognized projects demonstrating exceptional planning, design, and compatibility with the Lake Tahoe environment while following the guidelines set forth by the Agency. A new "green building" category was added this year to recognize the construction of environmentally-friendly projects. Local professionals in the fields of architecture, landscaping, planning, engineering, and resource management judged each category.
